Dear Ross Beattie:

The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable. This approval does not affect any conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Polixetonium Chloride Interim Decision, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling and must be used at your next label printing. Pursuant to 40 CFR 156.10(a)(6) you must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 12 months from the date of this letter. After 12 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling.

"To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under FIFRA and is subject to review by the Agency. See FIFRA section 2(p)(2). If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process, FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(B). Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance.

Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6. 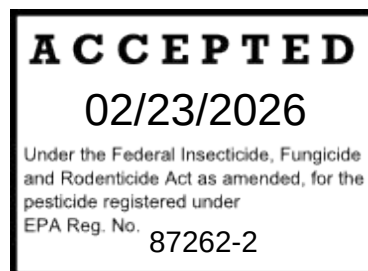

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Mayosperse 7700-30 is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, heated swimming pools, exterior whirlpools, hot baths, and decorative fountains. It is used to control algae, bacteria, and fungi in recirculating commercial and industrial cooling water towers.

In RECIRCULATING COOLING TOWERS and PULP/PAPER MILLS end use applications, applicators must develop a system management plan for achieving control of fouling with minimum amount of product required. Contact your distributor for assistance in developing a system management plan. The amount of product required will depend on the nature and extent of contamination, quality of the makeup water, and the degree of control required. Badly fouled systems must be cleaned before treatment is begun.

RECIRCULATING COOLING WATER TOWERS

Prior to using Mayosperse 7700-30 in recirculating cooling water towers, systems must be cleaned to remove algal growth, microbiological slime, and other deposits. Then make an initial slug addition of 1.8-4.4 fluid ounces of Mayosperse 7700-30 per 1000 gallons of water to provide 16-40 ppm Mayosperse 7700-30, based on the total weight of water in the system. Repeat initial dosage until control is evident. Make subsequent slug additions of 0.4-4.4 fluid ounces of Mayosperse 7700-30 per 1000 gallons of water (4-40 ppm) every 2-5 days or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleed-off and the severity of the microbiological problem. Slug additions shall be made in the cooling water tower sump.

INDUSTRIAL AIR WASHING SYSTEMS

Mayosperse 7700-30 is used to control bacteria in industrial air washing systems that maintain effective mist eliminating components. Prior to its use, systems must be cleaned to remove bacterial slime and other deposits. An initial slug dose of 6.66-11.1 fluid ounces of Mayosperse 7700-30 per 1000 gallons of water is required. Repeat initial dosage until control is evident. Subsequent slug additions of 4.5-11.1 fluid ounces of Mayosperse 7700-30 per 1000 gallons of water should be employed every 1-5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleed-off and severity of the bacterial problem. Slug additions may be made to the sump or to the water collection trays of the air wash system.

SWIMMING POOLS, HEATED SWIMMING POOLS, EXTERIOR WHIRLPOOLS, AND HOT BATHS

For maximum effectiveness of Mayosperse 7700-30 in swimming pools, heated swimming pools, exterior whirlpools, and hot baths, those with heavy growths of algae must be cleaned prior to using Mayosperse 7700-30. For pools having just visible algae growth, add an initial dose of 22-34 fluid ounces of Mayosperse 7700-30 per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool, add initially 12.0-22.0 fluid ounces of Mayosperse 7700-30 per 10,000 gallons of water. To maintain pools free of visible algae growth, subsequent additions of 4.0-8.0 fluid ounces of Mayosperse 7700-30 per 10,000 gallons of water must be made every 5-7 days after the initial treatment.

Uniform distribution of Mayosperse 7700-30 throughout the water in the pool is necessary for maximum effectiveness. Mayosperse 7700-30 is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. Mayosperse 7700-30 can be used in pools treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix Mayosperse 7700-30 with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

For spas, whirlpools or hot tubs, use an initial dose of 0.5 to 12 fluid ounces per 1000 gallons of water. For subsequent additions, add 0.2 to 9 fluid ounces per 1000 gallons of water every 5-7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

DECORATIVE FOUNTAINS

Mayosperse 7700-30 is used to control the growth of algae in decorative fountains. Systems containing heavy growths of algae must be manually cleaned prior to treatment. Fountains with just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 2.0-4.0 fluid ounces of Mayosperse 7700-30 per 1000 gallons of water in the system. To treat a freshly cleaned and filled fountain, add 1.0-3.0 fluid ounces of Mayosperse 7700-30 per 1000 gallons of water. Maintenance dosages of 0.4 to 1 fluid ounces of Mayosperse 7700-30 per 1000 gallons of water must be added every 5-7 days as needed. Additions of Mayosperse 7700-30 should be made at a point to ensure uniform distribution throughout the system. Mayosperse 7700-30 may be used in fountains treated with chlorine chemicals, but do not mix Mayosperse 7700-30 with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER, FOOD, OR FEED BY STORAGE OR DISPOSAL.

RESIDENTIAL USE: Keep container closed when not in use. Store in an area inaccessible to children and persons unfamiliar with its use. Leaking or damaged containers must be placed in a plastic bag

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in the trash

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Do not stack more than four (4) drums high. Leaking or damaged drums should be placed in over-pack drums for disposal. Spills should be absorbed in sawdust or sand and disposed of in a sanitary landfill. Keep container closed when not in use.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on-site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER HANDLING: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill. Triple rinse (or equivalent), then offer for: recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose in a sanitary landfill, incineration, or, if allowed, by state and local authorities, burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
