DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Mayosperse 7700 is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, heated swimming pools, exterior whirlpools, hot baths, and decorative fountains. It is used to control algae, bacteria, and fungi in recirculating commercial and industrial cooling water towers.

RECIRCULATING COOLING WATER TOWERS

Prior to using Mayosperse 7700 in <u>recirculating cooling water towers</u>, systems shall be cleaned to remove algal growth, microbiological slime, and other deposits. Then make an initial slug addition of 3.6-8.8 fluid ounces of Mayosperse 7700 per 1000 gallons of water to provide 8-20 ppm Mayosperse 7700, based on the total weight of water in the system. Repeat initial dosage until control is evident. Make subsequent slug additions of 0.8-8.8 fluid ounces of Mayosperse 7700 per 1000 gallons of water (2-20 ppm) every 2-5 days or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleed-off and the severity of the microbiological problem. Slug additions shall be made in the cooling water tower sump.

INDUSTRIAL AIR WASHING SYSTEMS

Mayosperse 7700 is used to control bacteria in industrial air washing systems that maintain effective mist eliminating components. Prior to its use, systems must be cleaned to remove bacterial slime and other deposits. An initial slug dose of 13.32-22.20 fluid ounces of Mayosperse 7700 per 1000 gallons of water is required. Repeat initial dosage until control is evident. Subsequent slug additions of 9.0-22.2 fluid ounces of Mayosperse 7700 per 1000 gallons of water should be employed every 1-5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleed-off and severity of the bacterial problem. Slug additions may be made to the sump or to the water collection frays of the air wash system.

SWIMMING POOLS, HEATED SWIMMING POOLS, EXTERIOR WHIRLPOOLS, AND HOT BATHS

For maximum effectiveness of Mayosperse 7700 in <u>swimming pools</u>, heated swimming <u>pools</u>, exterior whirlpools, and <u>hot baths</u>, those with heavy growths of algae must be cleaned prior to using Mayosperse 7700. For pools having just visible algae growth, add an initial dose of 44-68 fluid ounces of Mayosperse 7700 per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool, add initially 24-44 fluid ounces of Mayosperse 7700 per 10,000 gallons of water. To maintain pools free of visible algae growth, subsequent additions of 8-16 fluid ounces of Mayosperse 7700 per 10,000 gallons of water must be made every 5-7 days after the initial treatment

Uniform distribution of Mayosperse 7700 throughout the water in the pool is necessary for maximum effectiveness. Mayosperse 7700 is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. Mayosperse 7700 can be used in pools treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of the amount of the chemicals normally required. However, do not mix Mayosperse 7700 with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

DECORATIVE FOUNTAINS

Mayosperse 7700 is used to control the growth of algae in <u>decorative fountains</u>. Systems containing heavy growths of algae must be manually cleaned prior to treatment. Fountains with just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 4-8 fluid ounces of Mayosperse 7700 per 1000 gallons of water in the system. To treat a freshly cleaned and filled fountain, add 2-6 fluid ounces of Mayosperse 7700 per 1000 gallons of water. Maintenance dosages of 0.8-2.0 fluid ounces of Mayosperse 7700 per 1000 gallons of water must be added every 5-7 days as needed. Additions of Mayosperse 7700 should be made at a point to ensure uniform distribution throughout the system. Mayosperse 7700 may be used in fountains treated with chlorine chemicals, but do not mix Mayosperse 7700 with concentrated dry or lining chlorine and read and a second second

PAPER MANUFACTURE

Mayosperse 7700 will retard microbial growth that causes degradation of cooked starch used in paper manufacture. Mayosperse 7700 is added at a rate of 25-250 ppm based on the total weight of the starch and water. The treatment rate necessary to retard spoilage of the starch will vary with the extent of contamination of the make-up water and the length of storage.

NOTE: Do not use in paper and paperboard that will contact food.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
