
- 2. You must submit the following data before the due date of 10/31/2013:
 - a. Storage Stability (830.6317) and Corrosion Characteristics (830.6320) studies.

- 3. Make the following changes to the label:
 - a. Change the product registration number to "EPA Reg. No. 87284-3"
 - b. In paragraph 1 of the list of uses on page 2 delete "Berry Group", "Onions (dry bulb and green)" and "strawberry" and add "bulb onion subgroup 3-07A, green onion subgroup 3-07B, caneberry subgroup 13-07A, bushberry subgroup 13-07B, low growing berry subgroup 13-07G (except cranberry)"
 - c. In paragraph 2 of the list of uses on page 2 change "...pulp and paper." to "...pulp and paper (non-food uses)."

- 4. Submit one copy of the revised final printed label for the record before the product is released for shipment.

- (1) Almonds, Banana and Plantain, Berry Crop Group, Carrots, Celery and Leaf Petiole Subgroup, Cereals (Barley, Oats, Rye, Triticale, Wheat), Citrus (Non-bearing), Corn (Field, Pop, Sweet), Cranberries (OR, WA, WI only), Filberts, Grasses grown for Seed (ID, MN, NE, OR and WA only), Mint (Peppermint and Spearmint), Onions (dry bulb and green), Peanuts, Pecans, Pineapple (HI only), Pineapple (post-harvest), Pistachio, Rice, Sorghum, Soybeans, Stone Fruit, Strawberry, Sugar Beet, Sugarcane, Tree Nuts, Turf and Ornamental, Wild Rice (MN only), Parsley, Cilantro, Garden Beet.
- (2) Terrestrial non-food uses (aqueous and solvent based end use products) to protect wood against wood-rotting fungi and to protect millwork (window frames, wood doors, door frames.), in-ground contact uses (wood products – pilings, telephone poles, wood building materials), sapstain control (fresh-cut lumber). Preservation of leather, paint and coatings, caulk, adhesives, metal working fluids and pulp and paper.

Fill the container 1/4 full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. **Pressure rinse as follows:** Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Hold the container upside down over application equipment or mix tank or collect rinsate for later use or disposal. Insert pressure rinsing nozzle in the side of the container and rinse at about 40 psi for at least 30 seconds. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Then offer the drum for recycling, if available or dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by incineration or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
