The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable. This approval does not affect any conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. Pursuant to 40 CFR 156.10(a)(6) you must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

30 SECONDS® Spray & Walk Away [30 SECONDS® Wet & Walk Away] is specifically formulated to kill Lichen, Moss, Mold & Algae on roofs & other exterior surfaces outdoors. For use on outdoor surfaces listed on this label. Product is not for public health uses.

{note to EPA - the one gallon and 2.5 products use a standard mix method whereas the 32 oz., 48 oz. and 64 oz. products utilize the attached hose sprayer unit}

Shake contents before use.

[for one gallon and 2.5 gallon products] Mix one part of 30 SECONDS® Spray & Walk Away [30 SECONDS® Wet & Walk Away] to five parts water (1:5 mix ratio).

[for 32 oz., 48 oz. and 64 oz. products] Attach to garden hose. The hose attachment dispenses 1 part product to five parts water (1:5 mix ratio).

Spray surface to be treated when surface is DRY, and rain is not predicted for 12 hours or longer.

Use a backpack or pump up tank sprayer to apply. Thoroughly saturate surfaces to be treated. To maximize coverage, remove excessive organic growth or clumps where possible, prior to applying Spray and Walk Away. This will increase the effectiveness of the product.

Once treated, the surface requires no pressure washing, scrubbing or rinsing. Just thoroughly wet the surface and WALK AWAY. If the surface to be treated is not fully exposed to rainfall or is vertical, then some additional wetting of the surface may be required. Re-application may be required where heavy growth persists. Do not repeat treatment more than six (6) times per year.

30 SECONDS® Spray & Walk Away [30 SECONDS® Wet & Walk Away] is primarily designed for treating Lichen, Moss, Mold & Algae on ROOFS; Composite, Glazed Tile, Sealed Terracotta, Shingles, Concrete, Metal, Masonry, sealed Slate, or Plastic. 30 SECONDS® Spray & Walk Away [30 SECONDS® Wet & Walk Away] will also work on other outdoor surfaces like pathways, sealed brickwork, sealed concrete pool surrounds, tombstones, non-grass tennis courts, astro turf, asphalt driveways, vinyl and aluminum siding, painted non-porous surfaces, non-porous textured finishes, wood decks.

ADVICE FOR SPECIFIC SURFACES

<u>Wood Decks:</u> Growth on Cedar or Redwood may require brushing for complete growth removal. Use water and a hard broom 1 month after application. Once cleaned, it may be maintained with Spray and Walk Away to prevent further growth or stains.

<u>Play Equipment:</u> Do not allow children on play equipment (i.e. slide, plastic gyms) if it has been treated with Spray and Walk Away, until the equipment has been washed down with fresh water, at least 24 hours after application.

<u>Pets:</u> Keep animals off treated surfaces until product has dried. If contamination occurs, rinse animals paws with fresh water to prevent animal licking Spray and Walk Away.
