b. Revise the Precautionary statement to read "Causes irreversible eye and skin damage. May be fatal if swallowed or inhaled. Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. Wear protective goggles or face shield, protective clothing, and use only Neoprene gloves when handling this product. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

c. This product is only being registered as a Chlorine Dioxide Gas. Therefore, all directions for use of this product as an Aqueous Chlorine Dioxide solution have been removed from the labeling.

d. The unacceptable term "etc." has been removed from Section 4 (A) of the Operating Procedures.

e. The label must be updated for Container Disposal per PR-Notice 2007-4.

3. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.

In the event the container is damaged, combustible material contaminated with the product's contents may burn rapidly and liberate chlorine dioxide (a poisonous and explosive gas). Do not expose to hot surfaces, sparks or open flame.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Enerfab SC Cartridges may also be used to reduce the microbial load, such as yeast and molds, on hard surfaces within confined spaces, floors & walls of building interiors. Enerfab SC Cartridges are to be used in Enerfab CD Gas Generation System only and must be used by trained personnel. For proper generation and application of chlorine dioxide, you must follow the instructions supplied with the Enerfab CD Gas Generation System, Operating Guide.
