By Notification, United Pet Group, Inc. requests addition of Alternate Brand names and a minor wording revision to the Hazard Statement and to the Storage and Disposal Statement on the label for EPA Reg. No. 87703-2 8 IN 1 Mite & Lice Bird Spray. Other non-notification changes are also discussed.

An ownership change from Eight In One Pet Products (EPA Co. No. 1903) to United Pet Group, Inc.(EPA Co. No. 87703) has been approved. Address changes have been made to the accompanying label.

Enclosed please find a copy of the proposed Master Label with all changes highlighted in yellow; five (5) copies of a clean version of the same label; and a PDF copy on CD with a Certification of Label Integrity. A copy of the Market Label that was accepted on June 29, 2004 is also enclosed.

This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec, 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 98-10 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.
