The five-batch analysis for the above product, submitted as a condition of registration in the Agency's June 13, 2011 letter, is acceptable. This data also supports the current basic CSF dated May 19, 2011. The conditional one-year storage stability and corrosion characteristics studies have been submitted and are pending review.
