For use as a preventive treatment on concrete, and masonry (cinder block) products, including fabrication and repair of concrete sewer structures such as pipe and manholes. Not for use in the treatment of stormwater products.

For use as a Topical Application:

- Before applying this product, visible mold growth must be removed and conditions favorable to mold growth must be identified and corrected.
- For use on the surface of finished products prior to completion of construction, mix 8 16 ounces of ConBlock MIC₃₆ into a gallon of water. Use the higher concentration if the product to be treated is expected to remain in moist or wet condition for a prolonged period.
- Apply evenly by paint brush, airless sprayer, low pressure hand wand, or backpack sprayer.
- Allow treated surfaces to thoroughly dry before painting or affixing overlayment materials such as siding, wallboard or flooring.
