Store frozen (<-18°C). Reclose container of unused portions of *Helicoverpa zea* ABA-NPV-U.

CONTAINER HANDLING

Refillable container. Refill this container with *Helicoverpa zea* ABA-NPV-U only. Do not reuse this container for any other purpose.

Cleaning the container before final disposal is the responsibility of the person disposing of the container. Cleaning before refilling is the responsibility of the refiller. To clean the container before final disposal, triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times.
