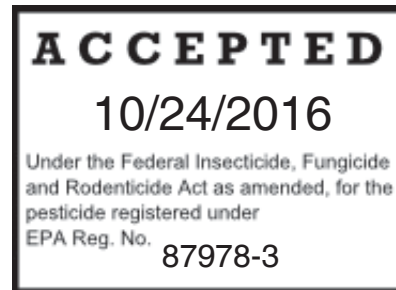

Store frozen (<-18°C). Reclose container of unused portions of *Spodoptera frugiperda* MNPV-3AP2.

Wastes resulting from the use of this product must be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER HANDLING

Refillable container. Refill this container with *Spodoptera frugiperda* MNPV-3AP2 only. Do not reuse this container for any other purpose.

Cleaning the container before final disposal is the responsibility of the person disposing of the container. Cleaning before refilling is the responsibility of the refiller. To clean the container before final disposal, triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into an approved waste disposal facility or manufacturing equipment. Fill the container ¼ full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into an approved waste disposal facility or manufacturing equipment, or store rinsate for later disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling if available or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration. Do not burn, unless allowed by state and local ordinances. If burned, stay out of smoke.
