This product is **conditionally** registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A), provided that:



2. You will make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment:
 - a) Revise the EPA Registration Number to read "EPA Reg. No. 88050-1."
3. This submission satisfies the data requirements corresponding to guidelines 830 Series Subgroups A & B, with the exception of storage stability (830.6317) and corrosion characteristics data (830.6320). A 1-year study, with observations made a 0, 3, 6, 9, and 12 months is required to satisfy these data requirements. Refer to the enclosed product chemistry review memorandum for details (Mathur, February 17, 2011). Please note that the data is due to the Agency no later than 16 months from the date of this letter (September, 2012).
4. The confidential statement of formula (CSF) dated 03/22/2011 is acceptable. This CSF supersedes the one dated 2/17/2011.

5. Submit two (2) copies of your final printed labeling before releasing the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

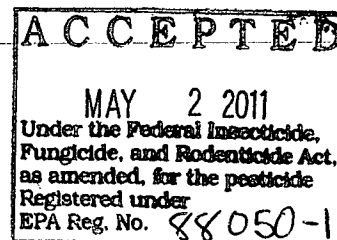

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This labeling must be in the possession of the user at the time of pesticide application.

Apply only with a VetCap® Approved Applicator Device (sold separately) and in accordance with its use directions and treatment method recommendations

Only apply when animal is between 20 feet and 30 feet distant from the user. Do not apply treatment when bystanders are within 20 feet of the animal.

Do not apply to any animals in or within 10 feet of bodies of water.

Do not leave intact gelcaps in the field.

Do not allow farm dogs or other farm animals to come into contact with the pesticide or residues.

Do not remove gelcaps from container until ready to apply.

AIM-c insecticide gelcaps are designed for use only with a compatible applicator device that carries the 'VetCap® Approved Application Device' label. Using any other application device or method could be unsafe, ineffective and/or cause harm or injury

How to Apply: Apply the required number of gelcaps to the upper two thirds of the side of the animal's body anywhere between the front shoulders and 6 inches ahead of the base of the tail. Where two capsules are required, apply one to each side of the animal.

Amount to Use: Apply AIM-c insecticide gelcaps at the dosages shown on the following table. Care must be taken to apply the correct dosage.

AIM-c can be used on beef and dairy cattle (including lactating) of all ages and sizes. Treatment for flies can be repeated as needed but not more often than once every 3 weeks. For optimal lice control, an initial application followed by a second treatment 3 weeks later is recommended.

AIM-c does not control cattle grubs.

NOTICE TO VETERINARIANS

As with all synthetic pyrethroids, a small percentage of animals may experience a temporary skin sensation known as paresthesia within 24 hours after application. Paresthesia is characterized by one or more of the following signs: head tossing, tail twitching, restlessness, and irritability. Generally, affected animals return to normal within 48 hours without treatment.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Not for Use or Storage In or Around the Home

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Disposal:
