The above registrations contain conditions calling for the registration to expire after two years. But for limited Agency resources, your request would have been granted prior to the expiration date. Additionally, your company is required to adhere to the spot-on label mitigation, and to submit quarterly enhanced incident reports and quarterly sales information for the above-referenced registrations.

The Agency has found your company to be in compliance with the terms and conditions for the subject products. You confirmed via email (dated 10/19/2023) that Chanelle Pharmaceuticals Manufacturing Ltd. has yet to manufacture and release for shipment these registered products. The Agency is therefore granting the requests to extend the two-year time-limited registration restrictions. As such, the following change is being made to the terms and conditions for the products listed above:

- **The two-year time-limited registration restriction has been extended. The new expiration date for the registrations listed above is February 13, 2026.**
