If swallowed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. • Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. • Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Note to Physician: Treatment: Atropine sulfate should be used for treatment. Administer repeated doses, 1.2 to 2.0 mg. intravenously every 10 to 30 minutes until full atropinization is achieved. Maintain atropinization until the patient recovers. Artificial respiration or oxygen may be necessary. Allow no further exposure to any cholinesterase inhibitor until recovery is assured. Do not use morphine or 2-PAM.
