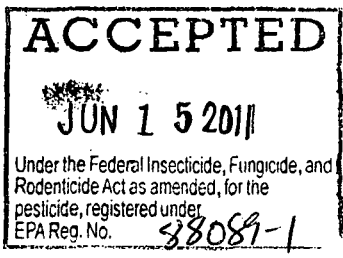

Pesticide Storage

Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling if available, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by incineration. Do not burn unless allowed by state and local ordinances.

SANOIENE preserves and aids in the control of the growth of odor-causing, discoloration, or spoilage bacteria and fungi in textiles.

Do not use articles that have been treated with SANOIENE as components in materials used in food packaging and food-holding.

How to treat fabrics with SANOIENE: Begin by diluting the SANOIENE by one kg of SANOIENE for every 16 kg of solution by adding water to equal the same weight of the textile to be treated. 500 kg of fabric is treated with 31.25kg of SANOIENE and 468.75 of water by dipping the fabric in a tank with the diluted solution; then remove excess solution from fabric by spinning in a de-watering machine and then place fabric in a tumbler dryer at 150-160 degrees C for two minutes. Let fabric cool and finish the process by simply washing and drying the textile in a normal washing machine and dryer.
