The Antimicrobials Division (AD) has conducted a review of this request for its applicability under PRN 98-10 and finds that the action requested falls within the scope of PRN 98-10.

The label submitted with the application has been stamped "Notification" and will be placed in our records.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance.

Micro-Pak® Enhanced Packaging Stickers are intended to [control] [inhibit] [mitigate] [odor causing bacteria,] mold and mildew on products enclosed in packaging intended for shipment. Items that may be packaged and treated in this manner would include footwear, clothing, luggage, handbags, purses, wallets, gloves, hats, belts, leather goods, sporting goods, furniture, gift and packing boxes, carpets, photo albums, musical instruments, toys, bracelets, jewelry, dolls, lamps, vases, baskets, pots, footwear components, bedding, tablecloths, floral products and other associated materials. Micro-Pak® Enhanced Packaging Stickers will keep products clean and fresh.

Open the Micro-Pak® Enhanced Packaging Stickers foil pouch. Remove a roll of Micro-Pak® Enhanced Packaging Stickers and place them in the Micro-Pak® dispenser box. At time of final packaging, place one piece of [Micro-Pak® Enhanced Packaging Stickers] [Micro-Pak® Stickers] in a shoe size box. Larger containers, such as those containing full size boots should have 2 [Micro-Pak® Enhanced Packaging Stickers] [stickers] inserted. The box should be closed immediately after putting the [Micro-Pak® Enhanced Packaging Stickers] [sticker] on the box base and not reopened. Any other larger boxes of protected items should contain approximately one [piece of Micro-Pak® Enhanced Packaging Stickers] [sticker] per each 2 cubic foot area. Any unfinished roll of [Micro-Pak® Enhanced Packaging Stickers] [Micro-Pak® Stickers] must be placed back in the foil pouch and closed with tape for use within the next 24 hours.
