- (2) **Terrestrial non-crops**: utility, highway, pipeline and railroad rights-of-way, petroleum tank farms, lumberyards, storage areas, industrial plant sites and around farm buildings.
- (3) Aquatic non-crops: irrigation and drainage ditches;
- (4) uses for which US EPA has accepted the required data and/or citations of data that the formulator has submitted in the support of registration;
- (5) uses for experimental purposes that are in compliance with U.S. EPA requirements.
