[(CGP-2013-MP)(brand name)(this product)] is intended to be added daily to whole milk or reconstituted milk replacers to control house flies, stable flies, horn flies, and face flies which develop in manure of (beef and dairy) calves (including yeal calves).

In order to achieve optimum fly control, use [(CGP-2013-MP)(brand name)(this product)] in conjunction with [other brand name] premise and on-animal products as well as good management and sanitation practices.



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

[(CGP-2013-MP)(brand name)(this product)] contains [(Dimilin®)(diflubenzuron)], [an][insect growth regulator][IGR] which prevents the development of house flies, stable flies horn flies, and face flies in the manure of treated calves, but is not effective against existing adult flies. Start feeding [(CGP-2013-MP)(brand name)(this product)] early in the spring [(3-4 weeks)(30 days)(1 month) before flies begin to appear, and continue feeding throughout the summer and into the fall until cold weather (restricts)(stops)(ends) fly activity. In some cases, supplemental fly control measures may be needed in and around [(pastures), (barns), (feedlots) and (calf hutches)] to control adult house and stable flies which [can breed in other decaying (organic)(vegetable) matter or (silage) in the area], or [that migrate in from other locations].

The dosage of [(CGP-2013-MP)(brand name)(this product)] is proportional to the animal's body weight. Each animal must receive 0.1 oz [(0.00625 lb)] of [(CGP-2013-MP)(brand name)(this product)] per 100 lbs of body weight, which equates to (0.10 mg diflubenzuron/kg of body weight) (4.54 mg diflubenzuron/100 lbs. of body weight) per day. The product can be mixed by either of the following two methods.

Restriction: Feed calves between the weight of 60-200 pounds not to exceed 0.1 mg/kg per day.

MIXING FOR INDIVIDUAL CALVES

Prepare the whole milk or reconstituted milk replacer for each individual calf. Add the appropriate amount shown below based on the calf's weight, to achieve 0.1 mg/kg.

1/2 teaspoon per 60 lb body weight

1 teaspoon per 120 lb body weight

1 1/2 teaspoon per 180 lb body weight

Mix thoroughly and feed the entire portion immediately. Repeat daily.

BULK MIXING FOR MULTIPLE CALVES

Thoroughly mix the required amount of [(CGP-2013-MP)(brand name)(this product)] as shown below into the total amount of whole milk or reconstituted milk replacer needed for the number of calves to be fed, using level measuring cups, teaspoons (tsp) or tablespoons (TBS). Prepare fresh daily to provide the labeled daily intake of (0.10 mg diflubenzuron/kg of body weight)(4.54 mg diflubenzuron/100 lbs. of body weight) per day. Feed each calf an equal portion of the total amount of treated milk.

(FOR 10 LB PAIL): Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Empty container by tapping side to apply contents as directed in the Directions for Use. Then offer for recycling if available or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by incineration.
