# PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**DANGER: Corrosive;** may cause severe skin irritation or chemical burns to broken skin. Causes eye damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. ### DIRECTIONS FOR SWIMMING POOL CHLORNITION

**For a new pool or for spring start-up**, super-chlorinate with one (1) pint (16 flu. ozs.) of sodium hypochlorite solution for each 2500 gallons of water. This dosage is equivalent to 5 ppm available chlorine by weight.

### For Pool Maintenance

Adjust pool water pH to 7.6 – 7.2 range and maintain.

Add Classic Pools Chlorine Solution manually or by a feeder device. Use Classic Pools Chlorine Solution sodium Hypochlorite solution at a rate to maintain an available chlorine sesidual of 0.6 to 1.0 ppm. One-half pint (8 fl. Ozs.), of Classic Pools Chlorine Solution for each 6000 galloris of water will provide 1.0 ppm available chlorine by vieight. Frequency of additions to maintain 0.5 –

1.0 ppm available chlorine will depend on temperature and number of swimmers. Use a test kit to make certain the pH and chlorine residual are in proper range.

**NOTE:** This product degrades with age. Use a chlorine test kit and Increase dosage as necessary, to obtain and maintain the required level of available chlorine

# STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**Store container** in a cool; dry area away from direct sunlight. In case of spill, flood area with large quantities of water.

**Non refillable Container.** Do not reuse or refill this container. If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling, if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

**Product or rinsate** that cannot be used should be diluted with water and disposed of in a sanitary sewer. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.
