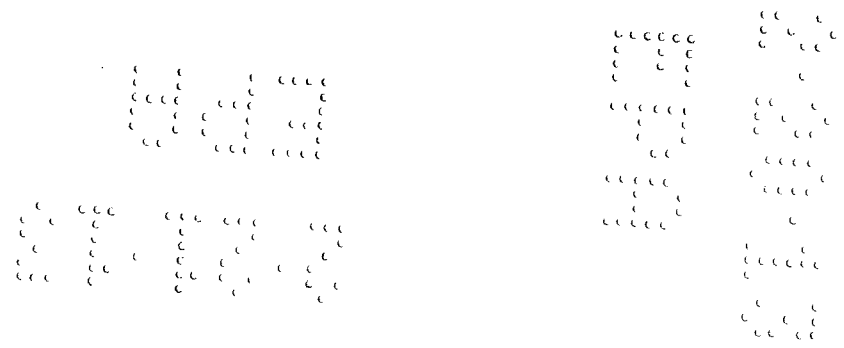

DIRECTIONS FOR SWIMMING POOL CHLORINATION

For a new pool or for spring start-up, super-chlorinate with one (1) pint (16 flu. ozs.) of sodium hypochlorite solution for each 2500 gallons of water. This dosage is equivalent to 5 ppm available chlorine by weight.

For Pool Maintenance

Adjust pool water pH to 7.6 – 7.2 range and maintain.

Add Classic Pools Chlorine Solution manually or by a feeder device. Use Classic Pools Chlorine Solution sodium Hypochlorite solution at a rate to maintain an available chlorine residual of 0.6 to 1.0 ppm. One-half pint (8 fl. Ozs.) of Classic Pools Chlorine Solution for each 6000 gallons of water will provide 1.0 ppm available chlorine by weight. Frequency of additions to maintain 0.5 –

1.0 ppm available chlorine will depend on temperature and number of swimmers. Use a test kit to make certain the pH and chlorine residual are in proper range.

NOTE: This product degrades with age. Use a chlorine test kit and Increase dosage as necessary, to obtain and maintain the required level of available chlorine

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store container in a cool; dry area away from direct sunlight. In case of spill, flood area with large quantities of water.

Non refillable Container. Do not reuse or refill this container. If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling, if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

Product or rinsate that cannot be used should be diluted with water and disposed of in a sanitary sewer. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.
