Submit these data within 90 days of the issuance date of this Notice of Pesticide Registration, except that 12 months are allotted for receipt of the batch analyses:
  - a) a manufacturing process amended to describe a method for identifying spores as *Beauveria bassiana* strain ANT-03;
  - b) batch analyses using viable count calculations;
  - c) specific methods for microbial contamination analyses;
  - d) defined rejection limits for contaminants; and
  - e) an explanation of unidentified fungi.


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4. Submit two (2) copies of the revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.
