 - 4. Handle the boxes according to company's standard operating procedures.
 - 5. Place the boxes of packed grapes in refrigerated storage at 0°-2°C (32°-35.6°F).
 - 6. Pad must be removed and disposed of prior to displaying grapes for sale.
 - 7. Do not allow consumers access to pads.
 - 8. If pad is torn, carefully dispose of pad, pad contents, and grapes which have contacted pad contents. Do not reuse the pad. Hold remainder of grapes for 24 hours before displaying.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
