In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under FIFRA and is subject to review by the Agency. Only for formulation into a herbicide for the following uses: asparagus, bush and caneberry crop group, citrus fruits (Crop Group 10-10), cranberry, field corn, flax, grasses grown for seed, millet, oats, okra, pome fruit (Group 11-10), popcorn, production seed corn, rhubarb, silage corn, sorghum, stone fruits (Crop Group 12-12), sugarcane, sweet corn, tree nuts (Crop Group 14-12), and turfgrass (including golf courses, institutional, commercial and residential lawns and landscapes, sod farms, sports fields, parks, municipal grounds, and cemeteries).

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Keep away from heat and flame. Do not store near seed, fertilizers, or foodstuffs. Can be stored at temperatures as low as minus 20°F. Open dumping is prohibited.
