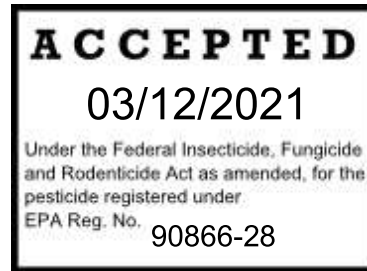

CHB-HS, with gibberellic acid and 3-indolebutyric acid as actives, is a specially designed plant growth regulator to increase weed susceptibility to selective postemergence herbicides.

Always make a sample of CHB-HS and other products to determine tank mix compatibility prior to application.

Mix the specified amount of CHB-HS in water to create a 1.0% solution and apply with sufficient volume for uniform and thorough coverage of foliage.

CHB-HS should be tank mixed at 1% (1 gallon per 100 gallons of final spray solution) when making postemergence application of herbicides in the WSSA groups listed below:
