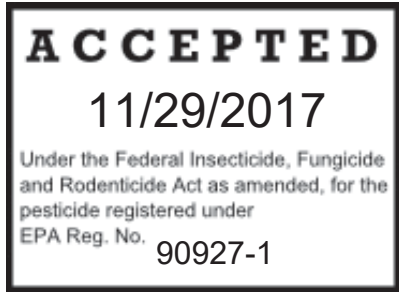

First Aid

USE RESTRICTIONS

Place the Last Treats bait stations where active ant* activity is present.

Ants* will die in their nest, not in the trap. The ant trap stays clean.

Last Treats continues to work on the second swarm of newly hatched ants*.

Replace the bait stations at least monthly.

* Except fire, harvester, pharaoh, and carpenter ants.

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store at room temperature away from sunlight. Do not store where children or animals may gain access.
