The amended labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable.

This approval does not affect any terms or conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing terms or conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one (1) copy of the final printed labeling before you release this product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR § 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR § 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to your company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under FIFRA and is subject to review by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). If the website is false or misleading, the product will be considered to be misbranded and sale or distribution of the product is unlawful under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR § 156.10(a)(5) lists examples of statements the EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the EPA find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false

FIRST AID

If swallowed:

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

For terrestrial uses: To protect the environment, do not allow pesticide to enter or run off into storm drains, drainage ditches, gutters or surface waters. Applying this product in calm weather when rain is not predicted for the next 24 hours will help to ensure that wind or rain does not blow or wash pesticide off the treatment area.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Use Deer Ban Deer Repellent Capsules to repel deer.

General: Animals use urine to communicate in the wild. When they repeatedly smell a predator's odor, animals conclude it's a dangerous place and choose instead to move elsewhere. Deer Ban Repellent Capsules create the illusion that coyotes are present in your lawn or garden so deer won't invade your lawn and garden.

Application Directions

Use Restrictions: This product is not for direct application to plants intended for human consumption (i.e. food plants). Apply only to the perimeter of where food plants are grown to create a repellent barrier. Do not open capsules or disperse contents directly onto plants intended for food use.

Disperse one capsule every 10 to 20 feet on your garden or flowerbed perimeter, ensuring there is a capsule on every outside corner. Do not open capsules or disperse contents directly onto ground. One capsule application lasts 30-90 days.

Deer Repellent Kits contain: 20, 50 or 150 Deer Ban Repellent Capsules

Replacement: Replace capsules as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place.

Container Handling: If empty: Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partially filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
