The Registration Division (RD) has conducted a review of this request for its applicability under PRN 98-10 and finds that the action requested falls within the scope of PRN 98-10.

#### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

How to Apply: A109.06 – 1 PT is a ready-to-use solution. [To use the package dispenser, hold the container upright, remove the cap from the dosage chamber and gently squeeze the sides of the bottle to fill the chamber to the desired dosage.] Apply the required amount of solution directly along the top of the back and top of the head of the animal.

**How to Apply: A109.06 – 6 PT** is a **ready-to-use** solution. Apply the required amount of solution directly along the top of the back and top of the head of the animal.

How to Apply: A109.06 – 1 GAL is a ready-to-use solution. Apply the required amount of solution directly along the top of the back and top of the head of the animal.

**Amount to Use:** Apply **A109.06** at the rates shown on the following table. Due to the small amount of material required, care must be taken to apply the correct amount.

**A109.06** can be used on beef and dairy cattle (including lactating) of all ages and sizes. Treatment for flies can be repeated as needed but not more often than once every 3 weeks. For optimal lice control, an initial application followed by a second treatment 3 weeks later is recommended.

A109.06 does not control cattle grubs.

#### **NOTICE TO VETERINARIANS**

As with all synthetic pyrethroids, a small percentage of animals may experience a temporary skin sensation known as paresthesia within 24 hours after application. Paresthesia is characterized by one or more of the following signs: head tossing, tail twitching, restlessness, and irritability. Generally, affected animals return to normal within 48 hours without treatment.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
