- 4. If, after formal consultation with the appropriate Service(s), additional modifications are identified in the Service's Biological Opinion(s) for dinotefuran, EPA will notify Atticus, LLC in writing consistent with the terms in the Biological Opinion(s) of any necessary required changes. Atticus, LLC must submit an application for amendment incorporating any required changes, including amended labels, consistent with the timeline specified in EPA's notification. If Atticus, LLC fails to comply with this term agreed upon in the previous written acceptance dated March 12, 2025, EPA may cancel the registration under an expedited process under FIFRA 6(e).

Use of this chemical in areas where soils are permeable, particularly where the water table is shallow, may result in ground water contamination. Periodic monitoring of shallow ground water in the use area is recommended.
