GENERAL INFORMATION

- Provivi[™] FAW Dispenser contains a synthetic pheromone that imitates the naturally occurring sex pheromones produced and released by the female fall armyworm, FAW (*Spodoptera frugiperda*). In nature, the male moth utilizes the naturally occurring pheromone to locate the female.
- The FAW pheromone is contained in, and released from, a solid matrix hand applied dispenser into the surrounding air, thereby disrupting the natural cues used by the male moth to locate the female. When the males cannot locate females, the mating process is disrupted and there will be no egg laying, hence, no larvae to cause crop damage.
- Provivi[™] FAW Dispenser is most effective when FAW pest pressure in the field is low to moderate. In the field with high pest pressure, chance encounters might happen and mating can still take place even with the use of the Provivi[™] FAW Dispenser. Regular monitoring of the moth population and/or crop infestation is essential to assess the effectiveness of the pheromone treatment in disrupting mating behavior. If monitoring shows the presence of FAW larvae in the field at or above a certain threshold level, then effective insecticide applications are advised.
- Mated females from untreated adjacent areas may fly into the treated blocks and may reduce the impact of mating disruption. So, pheromone treatment works better when the treated field is large and square or near square shape.
- Integrated Pest Management (IPM): For best results, use Provivi[™] FAW Dispenser as one of the components of IPM programs. Put special emphasis on preserving natural enemies, and implementing cultural practices known to reduce the development of FAW life stages.
