Dry cleaning removes the active ingredient.

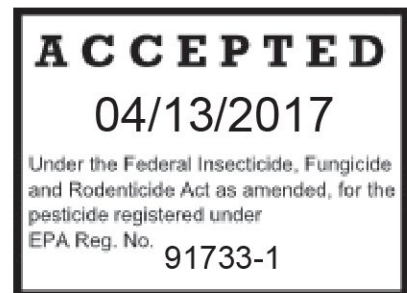
