This product is intended only for the production of herbicides for use on field corn, peanuts, chickpea (Garbanzo beans), brassica head and stem vegetables (subgroup 5A), cabbage, collards, mint, uses for which USEPA has accepted the required data and/or citations of data that the formulator has submitted in support of registration, or uses for experimental purposes that are in compliance with USEPA requirements. EPA approved labeling, which complies with all pertinent laws and regulations, is required for all formulations produced from this material and must be furnished by formulator.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in original container only. Store in a cool, dry place.

PRODUCT DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product must be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER HANDLING:

Nonrefillable Plastic and Metal Containers (Capacity Greater Than 50 Pounds): Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container 1/4 full with water. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then, for Plastic Containers, offer for recycling if available or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration. Do not burn, unless allowed by state and local ordinances.
