APPLICATIONS:

Postharvest citrus fruit treatment, to improve their appearance, increasing the shine, reducing loss of weight and slowing the process of senescence by reducing the fruit transpiration and gives fungicide protection against fungi that cause decay (*Penicillium*, *Diploida*, etc). This product may be used in combination with other post-harvest imazalil products at different stages in harvest, storing, and packing.

APPLICATIONS RATES:

IN CITRUS PACKOUT WAX: Apply in conventional waxing equipment at 1 gallon of product per 10,000 to 12,000 lb. of citrus fruit to achieve a use concentration of 3000 ppm Imazalil. Stir product thoroughly for 5 minutes prior to application to the citrus fruit and continue slow agitation of the wax during the application process. The fruit should be dry when the wax treatment is applied. To apply to the citrus fruit on a roller conveyor, spray wax using waxing equipment while the citrus fruit passes on the conveyor. Allow the brushes to distribute the wax. Check nozzles frequently for blockage to ensure that the wax treatment is applied evenly.

IN CITRUS STORAGE WAX: Apply in conventional waxing equipment at 1 gallon per 10,000 to 12,000 lb. of citrus fruit to achieve a use concentration of 3000 ppm Imazalil. Stir the prepared wax thoroughly for 5 minutes before applying and continue slow agitation of the wax during the application process. The fruit should be dry when the wax treatment is applied. To apply to the citrus fruit on a roller conveyor, spray wax using waxing equipment while the citrus fruit passes on the conveyor. Allow the brushes to distribute the wax. Check nozzles frequently for blockage to ensure that the wax treatment is applied evenly.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in a cool place (41 - 95°F).

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product must be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Non-Refillable Container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container ¼ full with water. Recap and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling if available or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration.
