Dear Ms. Tillman:

This letter is in reference to your request dated April 3, 2019 to extend the conditional time-limited registration for TEVRA Imidacloprid + Pyriproxyfen Spot On for Cats (EPA Reg. No. 92413-10).

The above-referenced registration contains conditions calling for the registration to expire two years from the date the product was conditionally registered (i.e., August 30, 2017). Additionally, your company is required to adhere to the spot-on label mitigation, submit quarterly enhanced incident reports and quarterly sales information for each of the above registrations.

The Agency has found TEVRA in compliance with the terms and conditions for the subject product to date, which include:

- 1) Compliance with data requirements for Imidacloprid GDCI-129099, Imidacloprid EDSP-129099, Pyriproxyfen GDCI-129032, and Pyriproxyfen EDSP-129032, submitted to the Agency on November 14, 2017.
- 2) A mock up copy of the label was submitted on February 5, 2019 (Decision No. 550290) for Agency review and is approved with this letter.
- 3) Data requirements for storage stability and corrosion characteristics were submitted for review on February 28, 2019 (Decision No. 549268) and are under review.
- 4) To date, TEVRA has not marketed this product for sale and therefore has not submitted quarterly sales and incident data.

Therefore, the following change is being made to the terms and conditions of the products listed above:

• The 2-year time-limited registration restriction has been extended an additional two (2) years. The new expiration date for the subject product registration is now August 30, 2021.
