This product is only for use in the Larvanator ALD-365 Automatic Larvicide Dispensing Device. This device releases effective levels (0.5 grams) of insect growth regulator every 30 days for 1 year. Follow device instructions for set-up and installation. This packet will treat approximately 9 gallons of standing water over a 1-year period.

Treated larvae continue to develop normally to the pupal stage where they die. This product has no effect on mosquitoes/midges which have reached the pupal or adult stage prior to treatment.

Application sites: For use in drainage areas, ditches, storm water drainage areas, catch basins and other water holding depressions.

Application of this product to sites subject to water flow or exchange will diminish the product's effectiveness.

Storage and Disposal

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool, dry place.
