APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

Timbertreat® ICA-20 may be applied by flood, dip or spray to wood or wood products such as OSB, plywood and LVL to provide protection against decay and wood destroying insects. It can be combined with other registered fungicides or insecticides at the point of application to provide broad spectrum protection. It can also be combined with other ingredients such as diluents or surfactants at the point of application to enhance penetration into wood. For best results the solution should be kept hot during application.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
Storage: Store this product in its originally labeled container in a storage area located in a cool place. Keep container and freshly treated articles away from high temperature areas, sparks, or open flames.
