FOR TREATMENT OF BURLAP

LOSPOS-241 is a copper-based mildewcide specifically formulated to impart fungus resistance on burlap for agricultural, horticultural, nursery or military uses. For agricultural applications LOSPOC-241 treated burlap must not be used in contact with food products or with fruit bearing plants.

Dip Application:

Dilute the LOSPOC-241 solution with water to achieve a metallic copper (Cu) content ranging from 1.0 - 2.0% (10,000 - 20,000 ppm). Fully immerse the burlap into the solution until the material is saturated.

Note: Treating vessels (tanks) and associated equipment e.g. piping valves and fittings should not contain brass or bronze.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool, dry area inaccessible to persons unfamiliar with its use.

Ground water contamination may be reduced by diking and flooring of permanent liquid bulk storage sites with an impermeable material.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. Then offer for recycling if available, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or by other procedures approved state and local authorities.
