This conversion is accomplished using a process called electrolysis that employs an electrolytic cell. Force of Nature Appliance makes solution on demand as initiated by the User.

- 1. Fill Force of Nature Activator Bottle to fill line with tap water (347 gm). Note: water should be less than 100 ppm hardness for optimum device longevity.
- 2. Add one Force of Nature Activator Capsule (3.35 gm) to Bottle. [Use only Force of Nature Activator Capsules when making Force of Nature Electrolyzed Water Solution]
- 3. Press "Start" button

[Alternative Operating Instructions for 64 oz size]

- 1. Fill Force of Nature Activator Bottle to desired Fill Line with tap water. (938 gm for 32 oz batch, 1877 gm for 64 oz batch) Note: water should be less than 100 ppm hardness for optimum device longevity.
- 2. Add one x 10 ml Force of Nature Pro Activator Capsule for 32 oz batch. Add two x 10 ml Force of Nature Pro Activator Capsules for 64 oz batch.
- 3. Press desired batch size "Start" button. Button 1 for a 32 oz batch. Button 2 for a 64 oz batch.







Cleaning and Disinfecting Tips

GLASS AND STAINLESS STEEL Force of Nature doesn't contain drying accelerants like ammonia or alcohol-based products, so the trick is to spray then wipe with a clean dry cloth or paper towel until the surface is 100% dry.

SOAP SCUM Soap scum builds up in layers, so depending on build up and surface porosity, you may need a mild abrasive like baking soda with a scrub brush the first couple of times to break down the layers.

GREASE AND OIL Thoroughly saturate surface then wipe thoroughly with a clean dry cloth or paper towel. If you have a lot of grease, spray, then let sit 2 minutes before wiping.

PET ACCIDENTS First test in an inconspicuous spot to ensure the rug is truly colorfast. Start by removing as much of the soil as possible. Then saturate the area (if the accident got to the back of the rug, you want to saturate that too), then let dry without rinsing.

SPORTS GEAR For the first treatment, fully saturate the surface, then let dry without rinsing. After that, spray after each use to keep that eye-watering stench from returning.

FLOORS A refillable spray mop with a machine-washable pad and Force of Nature can be your new best friends. You can finally skip that rinsing step —YAY! If your floors are made from a material other than wood, sealed stone, porcelain, ceramic, vinyl or laminate, first test in an inconspicuous spot.

COLORFAST RUGS, FURNITURE, CLOTHING Always first test in an inconspicuous spot to ensure the item is truly colorfast. As with any stain remover, the sooner you treat the stain the better! And don't use on fabric that says "use non-chlorine bleach only".



- 1. Fill the Pro Appliance with cool water to the desired Fill Line.
- 2. Plug the power cord into the Pro Appliance and into the outlet.

Maintenance
