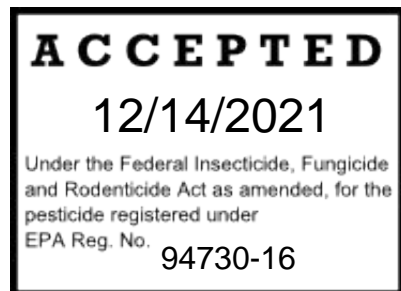

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

- Alfalfa, corn (all types), cotton, grain sorghum (milo), peanut, soybean, and sugar beet.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Proper pesticide storage and disposal are essential to protect against exposure to people and the environment due to leaks and spills, excess product or waste, and vandalism. Do not allow this product to contaminate water, foodstuffs, feed, or seed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store pesticides away from food, pet food, feed, seed, fertilizers, and veterinary supplies. Keep container closed to prevent spills and contamination.

Pesticide Disposal: To avoid wastes, use all material in this container, including rinsate, by application in accordance with label directions. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container 1/4 full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times.] Then offer for recycling if available or reconditioning, if appropriate, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures allowed by State and local authorities.]

Pressure rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into formulating equipment and continue to drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Hold container upside down over formulating equipment or collect rinsate for later use or disposal. Insert pressure rinsing nozzle in the side of the container, and rinse at about 40 PSI for at least 30 seconds. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Then offer for recycling if available or reconditioning, if appropriate, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures allowed by State and local authorities.

[Refillable Mini-bulk or Bulk Containers (50 gallons or more): Refillable container. Refill this container with [pesticide][acetochlor] only. Do not use this container for any other purpose. [For All Other Refillable Containers, Except Transport Vehicle Containers: Refillable container. Refill this container with [pesticide][acetochlor] only.
