#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

#### TO OPEN PACKAGE:

Open the package, take out the wet towel and unfold it, wipe and clean the necessary surface thoroughly, and dry it naturally. Discard after a single use.

**TO CLEAN:** Wipe the surface with the wipe. Let air dry.

#### TO DISINFECT:

- 1. The surfaces to be treated Must be hard, non-porous.
- 2. Pre-clean surfaces if they are visibly dirty or soiled prior to disinfection.
- 3. Wipe hard, non-porous surfaces until visibly wet.
- 4. Leave the surface visibly wet for 8 minutes. Let air dry. No rinsing is required.

#### SRORAGE AND DISPOSAL
