#### GENERAL INFORMATION

V10 is a suspension concentrate containing the mild *Pepino mosaic virus* isolates VX1 of the LP strain and VC1 of the CH2 strain. V10 protects tomato plants grown in commercial production greenhouses from aggressive strains of the *Pepino mosaic virus* by cross-protections.

#### USE INFORMATION

**CROP:** Greenhouse tomato

**PEST/DISEASE:** Pepino mosaic virus (strains CH2, EU and LP)

RATE:

Spray Application: 32 fl. oz. V10 / 1,000 ft.2 of plant bed in a total water-based application mixture of 12 gals. / 1,000 ft.2

of plant bed/indoor cultivation area.

**Rubbing Application:** 0.3 fl. oz. V10 / 1,000 ft.<sup>2</sup> in total water-based application mixture of 2.5 fl. oz. / 1,000 ft.<sup>2</sup> of plant

bed/indoor cultivation area.

#### APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

#### **Spray Application:**

<u>Preparation of Spray Liquid:</u> Shake the product thoroughly before use. Prepare V10 as a 2% solution (mixing 32 fl. oz. V10 in 12 gals. water) and stir well. Add synthetic sand at 1.1 oz. (30 g) / gal. of V10 spray liquid and stir well. Use 12 gals. of V10 spray liquid per 1,000 ft.<sup>2</sup> of plant bed.

<u>Application method:</u> Boom height should be approximately 4-6 in above the crop. Product should be sprayed at 12-15 bar (measure at spray boom).

#### **Rubbing Application:**

<u>Preparation of Application Mixture:</u> Shake the product thoroughly before use. Prepare V10 as a 10% solution (mixing 0.3 fl. oz. V10 in 2.5 fl. oz. water) and stir well. Add synthetic sand at 2 oz. (57 g) / gal. of V10 application mixture and stir well. Use 2.5 fl. oz. of V10 application mixture per 1,000 ft.<sup>2</sup>.

<u>Application Method:</u> Moisten a clean scouring pad in the application mixture. Rub the scouring pad over the top side of a leaf, just under the head at the middle height (rub with one hand and press with the other hand on the lower side of the leaf). The scouring pad should remain imbibed with the application mixture liquid so moisten it every 10-15 plants.

#### **Timing of Application:**

Make a single application to young seedlings, before or after transplanting and between the 3-leaf stage and first flower open stage (BBCH 13-61). Plants must be free of *Pepino mosaic virus* at the time of application.

#### Post application information:

Crop maintenance should be conducted immediately after application of V10 to ensure rapid and homogenous spread of the inoculum. At 4-6 weeks after application of V10, leaf samples should be tested to confirm that the treated plants have been colonized with each of the attenuated isolates, VX1 and VC1 of the LP and CH2 strains, respectively.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

**Pesticide Storage:** Store frozen below -15°C (5°F). Avoid exposure to heat. Do not refreeze after thawing. Do not sell or use 6 months after date of manufacture. See label or bottle for date of manufacture.

**Pesticide Disposal:** To avoid wastes, use all material in this container by application according to label directions. If wastes cannot be avoided, offer remaining product to a waste disposal facility or pesticide disposal program (often such programs are run by state or local governments or by industry).

[Container Handling (less than or equal to 5 gallons): Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container ½ full with water and recap. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling if available, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by incineration. Do not burn unless allowed by state and local ordinances.]

[Container Handling (greater than 5 gallons): Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container ½ full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal.


