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- 2. You are required to comply with the data requirements described in the generic data call-in (GDCI) identified below:

- 3. The data requirements for storage stability and corrosion characteristics (Guidelines 830.6317 and 830.6320) are not satisfied. The tests should be done for 1 year at room temperature or accelerated storage stability and corrosion studies for 2 weeks at 54°C with the product in its commercial package or in smaller packages of the same construction and materials.

 - Add an appropriate EPA Establishment Number and Net Contents information.
- 5. Submit one copy of the final printed label for the record before you release the product for shipment.
