NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Glufosinate-ammonium is a glutamine synthetase inhibitor and can interfere with neurotransmitter function. Symptoms may be delayed by up to 48 hours following ingestion. There is no specific antidote. If ingested, endotracheal intubation and gastric lavage should be performed as soon as possible, followed by charcoal and sodium sulfate administration.

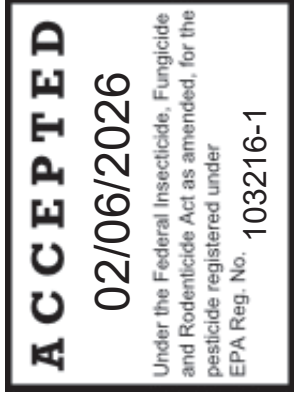
