The Agency is in receipt of your Application for Pesticide Notification under Pesticide Registration Notice (PRN) 98-10 for the above referenced product. The Registration Division (RD) has conducted a review of this request for its applicability under PRN 98-10 and finds that the action requested falls within the scope of PRN 98-10.

The label submitted with the application has been stamped "NOTIFICATION" and placed in our records.

The primary brand name has been changed from "ARG 2,4-D Amine Manufacturing Concentrate" to "Rainbow 2,4-D Amine Manufacturing Concentrate" and added to the product record.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) lists examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. For Formulation Into An Herbicide for Use Only On The Following Crops: com, Sorghum (milo), small grains (wheat, oats, barley and rye), rice, soybeans (preplant), sugarcane, grass pastures, rangeland, fallow cropland, areas in the conservation reserve program, grass seed crops, orchard floors (apple, pear, fruit, citrus, and nut); And For The Following Non-Crop Uses: Turf (including lawns, golf courses, cemeteries, parks, airfields), roadsides, non-cropland areas including rights-of-way, railroads, drainage ditch banks, fence rows, tree injection treatments, forest site preparation, forest conifer release, woody plant control in non-cropland areas and aquatic weed control.

- c. The maximum application rate to pasture and rangeland is the lower of 1) existing application rate on currently registered label or 2) 2 pounds 2,4-D acid equivalent per acre per application site
- The maximum application rate to forestry site preparation is the lower of 1) existing application rate on currently registered label or 2) 4 pounds 2,4-D acid equivalent per acre per application

- site. The maximum rate to all forestry sites is the lower of 1) existing application rate on currently registered label or 2) 4 pounds 2,4-D acid equivalent per acre per application site
- A reentry interval is required and should be in accordance with the Worker Protection Standards, 40 CFR parts 156 and 170.

#### 2. For Industrial / Aquatic Uses

- a. The maximum non-crop application rate for tree, brush and woody plant control on rights- of-way is the lower of 1) existing application rate on currently registered label or 2) 4 pounds 2,4-D acid equivalent per acre per application site. The maximum seasonal application rate to non-crop sites is 4 pounds 2,4-D acid equivalent per acre per application sites.

#### 3. For Residential and Turf Sites (Excluding Sod Farms)

It is recommended, that safety glasses include front, brow and temple protection."
- b. Personal Hygiene Statements: 1) For All Granular Products: "After using this product, remove clothing and launder separately before reuse and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water." 2) For All Liquid Products: "After using this

- product, rinse gloves before removing, remove clothing and launder separately before reuse, and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water." Remove saturated clothing as soon as possible and shower.
- c. The maximum application rate to turf is the lower of 1) existing application rate on currently registered label or 2) 2 pounds 2,4-D acid equivalent per application per site. The maximum number of broadcast applications per treatment site is 2 per day.
- d. The following reentry statement must be included: "DO NOT allow people (other than applicator) or pets on treatment area during application. DO NOT enter treatment areas until spray has fried or dust has settled."

# Storage and Disposal

**Prohibitions: DO NOT** contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. **Storage:** Keep container tightly closed when not in use. **DO NOT** store near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides or fungicides. **DO NOT** store below temperature of 45 degrees F (7 degrees C). If frozen (crystallized) warm to 80-90 degrees F) 27- 32 degrees C) and re-dissolve before using by rolling or shaking the container. Store in a safe manner. Store in original container only.
