This letter acknowledges receipt of an amendment for the above-listed Special Local Need (SLN) registration pursuant to Section 24(c) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. The original SLN registration permits use of Orthene® 97 (acephate) at an increased rate to control red-banded stinkbug populations in soybeans in Arkansas. This amendment extends the expiration date to December 31, 2026.
