Use a 6% concentration (7.3 pounds/ 1000 cu. ft.).

Dilution Rate:

Method of Application:

Release gas from a compressed cylinder into fumigation chamber

or room immediately before introducing sulfur dioxide.

Frequency/Timing of Application:

Treatment with carbon dioxide and sulfur dioxide is done one time during the initial sulfur dioxide post-harvest fumigation for 30 minutes, performed before

the grapes have been pre-cooled.

Restricted Entry Interval (REI): The chamber shall be aerated until at least 30 chamber volumes or air have been exhausted before workers may reenter (see other requirements below).

Pre-harvest Interval (PHI): N/A

Other Requirements:

Following aeration testing shall be done using length-of-stain type detectors tubes to ensure airborne levels of CO₂ and SO₂ are blow levels of concern before workers enter the chamber. Tubes are available for sulfur dioxide, carbon dioxide and oxygen deficient conditions.

2. If respiratory protection is necessary, only SCBA or combination Airline/SCBA is allowable and appropriate for protection against either CO₂ or SO₂ or oxygen deficient conditions.

Valid until withdrawn, suspended or cancelled by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA), the manufacturer, the 24(c) registrant, or the Department of Pesticide Regulation, or expires.
