This letter acknowledges receipt of an amendment for the above-listed Special Local Need (SLN) registration pursuant to Section 24(c) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. The original SLN registration permits use of Carzol SP (formetanate hydrochloride) to control insects in alfalfa grown for seed in Colorado. You indicated that this SLN is to extend the expiration date for an additional five years to 12/31/2026. Therefore, revisions were made to the 24(c) label, and thus a need for this SLN amendment. All other aspects remain the same.

The Agency has completed a review of the amendment of this use and acknowledges the State's Special Local Need registration, as amended. - This label must be in possession of the user at the time of pesticide application.

- Do not enter or allow entry into treated areas during the restricted entry interval of 4 days. The REI is 6 days for treated alfalfa grown for seed when hand-setting irrigation.
- Use this product only on pure stands of alfalfa to be harvested for seed.
- Do not allow spray to drift onto adjacent crops.
- This product is toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment. Do not apply this product while bees are actively visiting the treatment area.
- Do not allow livestock to graze treated fields. Do not use treated crops for livestock feed. Crop residues are not to be fed to livestock or baled for such use.
- Treated alfalfa seed is not to be used for sprouting. All alfalfa seed treated with CARZOL SP is to be tagged at the conditioning plant, "NOT FOR HUMAN OR ANIMAL CONSUMPTION". It shall be the grower's responsibility to notify the conditioning plant of any alfalfa seed crop treated with CARZOL SP.
- CARZOL SP does not control aphids. If aphids appear, add an aphicide to the spray.
- Do not apply more than 1 lb. CARZOL SP per acre in one crop season.
- The pre-harvest interval is 21 days.
- Hand harvesting is prohibited.
- Follow the listed rotational crop intervals after the last application of Carzol SP to alfalfa:
- 1. 30 days for leafy vegetables
- 120 days for root crops
- 12 months for small grains and all other crops (except leafy vegetables and root crops)
