This letter acknowledges receipt of an amendment for the above-listed Special Local Need (SLN) registration pursuant to Section 24(c) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. The original SLN registration permits use of Brigade 2EC Insecticide/Miticide (Bifenthrin) on Kentucky Bluegrass grown for seed to control mites. This amendment will extend the expiration date to December 31, 2026. All other aspects remain the same.

### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

- Apply as insects appear in sufficient volume of water to ensure thorough coverage.
- Apply as a broadcast spray with either ground or aerial application equipment. Apply in a minimum of 10 gallons of
  finished spray per acre by ground or 2 gallons per acre by air. Higher volumes of finished spray may improve insect
  control when temperatures are high, foliage is dense and/or when insect pressure is high.
- Make applications when pest populations reach economic thresholds or when significant feeding is occurring. Refer to local Cooperative Extension Pest Management Guidelines and/or scouting results.

#### **RESTRICTIONS:**

- Do not apply more than 0.2 lb ai/A (12.8 fl oz/A) per season.
- Do not make applications less than 14 days apart.
- Do not apply within 30 days of harvest.
- Do not graze livestock in treated areas or cut treated crops for feed.
- Do not apply Brigade 2EC Insecticide/Miticide or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds while bees are actively foraging in the treatment area.
