This letter acknowledges receipt of an amendment for the above-listed amended Special Local Need (SLN) registration pursuant to Section 24(c) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. The original SLN registration permits use of the product Spartan® Charge Herbicide (sulfentrazone and carfentrazone) to control kochia, Eastern black nightshade, and other problematic weeds on dry beans. This amended SLN updates the label by including the MOA box and extending the expiration date to January 1, 2025.
