**SUBJECT:** PC Codes: 071001, derris resins other than rotenone, 071003, rotenone and 071004, cube resins other than rotenone, registrations and use sites eligible for reregistration and for inclusion in the red legged frog endangered species risk assessment.

---

On June 7, 2006 a notice was published in the federal register requesting the voluntary cancellation of all rotenone uses on livestock, residential and home owner use, domestic pet uses, and all other uses except for piscicide (fish kill) uses. The technical registrants requested and were allowed to continue to sell existing stocks which included the above use sites until March 11, 2008. The reregistration eligibility decision (RED) for rotenone was signed on March 2007 and only addressed the remaining piscicide uses. All other uses were not included in the RED since they had been voluntarily cancelled.

PC code 071001: derris resins other than rotenone-all products voluntarily cancelled  
PC code 071003: rotenone-eligible uses include piscicide use only  
PC code 071004: cube resins other than rotenone-eligible uses include piscicide use only

The following use sites listed on the General Chemical Report for PC code 071003, dated 2/1/08 and for PC code 071004, dated 1/15/2008 are eligible for reregistration and should be included in the red legged frog risk assessment:

Streams/Rivers/Channeled Water  
Aquatic Areas/Water  
Lakes/Ponds/Reservoirs (with human or wildlife use)  
Lakes/Ponds/Reservoirs (without human or wildlife use)
