PREP's Online Training of the FIFRA Section 18 Emergency Exemption Program: Transcript for Navigation Module

Slide 1

Welcome to the Pesticide Regulatory Education Program's (PREP) training on the requirements and use of the Section 18 Emergency Exemption Program. Before we begin, let's go over instructions on how to navigate through this course.

Slide 2

To view the modules you will need one of the following browsers: Internet Explorer, version 7 or later, Mozilla Firefox, version 6 or later, or Apple Safari, version 5 or later.

To view the modules you will need Adobe Flash, version 7 or later installed on your computer. Also, to view the reference material attachments, you will need Adobe Acrobat Reader, version 7 or later.

Slide 3

This presentation will look best if your monitor is set at or above 1024x768. If your resolution is any lower, you may have to use scroll bars to view the entire presentation.

Slide 4

The format of the training is a slide presentation with voiceover that plays in a web browser. Features include decision tree graphics, supplemental reference information and links to resources. At the end are some interactive scenarios to reinforce some key learning points.

Slide 5

Use the tabs on the upper left-hand side of the screen to choose between the Transcript, Outline, Thumbnails and Search views.

The first tab, called Transcript, provides a full transcript for every slide. This option allows you to read through the transcript if you are unable to listen to the audio component of the module.

The second tab, called Outline, provides a listing of all the slides in this module. You may click on any slide title to quickly get to a particular slide.

The third tab, called Thumbnails, displays miniature images of each slide. (On some slides the images may appear superimposed.) You may click on any thumbnail to quickly get to a particular slide.

The fourth tab, called Search, allows you to quickly locate specific words used in that module.

The audio control button will adjust the audio volume. This button is located at the bottom of the screen. To adjust the volume, click on the button then move the slider bar up or down.

The slide control bar has three sections.

The first section indicates the current slide number and the total number of slides in that module.

The small arrow allows you to move within a slide. Simply move the arrow left or right to move to a different portion of the slide.

The middle section shows the status of the presentation – whether it is currently playing or paused or when to advance to the next slide.

The last section shows the length of time remaining in the current slide. Next are the playback controls.

You can play or pause the module by pressing the round button. If you want to move to the next or go back to the previous slide, click the forward or backward arrow.

The square button on the right is for the presentation mode. It allows you to control how the module is viewed. You have the option to show the navigation panel on the right, display the main content window only, or zoom in on the main content window.

Some of the modules have additional information supplied as attachments and you may access those by either clicking the resources button in the upper right corner of the screen or by clicking on the attachment prompts provided in the body of the slide where indicated.

Slide 6

This online course should take you approximately three hours to complete; however, you may exit at any point and, upon returning, you will be reminded of where you left off.

Proceed to the Introduction module to begin the course.
