Subject: PM2.5 Designations and Broomfield

Hi Libby. In response to your inquiry, the City and County of Broomfield should be designated as attainment for PM2.5. Broomfield County was not in existence when the AQCR were developed and published in the CFR. Most of Broomfield County was carved out of Adams, Boulder, and Jefferson Counties, with a small portion carved out of Weld County. If the AQCRs were revised, Broomfield would likely be added to the Denver-Boulder Area AQCR, which now reads as follows:

Denver - Boulder Area: Attainment  
Adams County (part) West of Kiowa Creek  
Arapahoe County (part) West of Kiowa Creek  
Boulder County (part) Excluding Rocky Mtn. National Park  
Denver County  
Douglas County  
Jefferson County

and not AQCR 2, which reads:

State AQCR 02: Attainment  
Larimer County  
Weld County

So, for the purpose of your approval of the PM2.5 designations, assume Broomfield is part of the Denver-Boulder Area AQCR.
